TTTU is a fully registered local company, in existence since Oct 2003, with equipment support from Tiger Offshore of Beaumont, Texas, USA (in operation since 1997) and with parent company Dragon Products (in operation since 1952). We are the first and largest supplier of Logistic Offshore Cargo Carrying Equipment (CCEs) in the region, and provide our services to most of the energy-related companies throughout T&T, Venezuela and the Caribbean.

As manufacturers of our own equipment, TTTU adheres to U.L. listings, STI (Steel Tank Institute) ABS, ASME, AWS and DOT Standards and are code rated with a "U" and "R" Stamp. All of TTTU's logistical equipment are engineered, designed and built to provide our customers with the safest, most effective way to transport materials and

equipment.

Although our starting and core business is the sale and rental of CCEs, TTTU has rapidly diversified its operations throughout the years to encompass:
